

School Admission Appeals Timetable 1 March 2018 - 28 February 2019

School Admission appeals are administered in accordance with the requirements of the 2012 School Admission Appeals Code issued by the Department for Education. Parents whose admission application is refused will have the legal right to appeal that decision. To lodge an appeal, complete and return the Appeal Form which can be downloaded from the Academy website or requested from the main Reception Office. On receipt of the completed Appeal Form, the Admission Authority will arrange for an appeal hearing to take place before an independent Appeal Panel. The timetable differs depending on when the appeal is lodged and whether it relates to an application to start or transfer to the Academy in September 2018 or to join the Academy during the academic year.

Appeals lodged after the 31 March or 26 May deadlines

It may be possible for appeals lodged after the appeal deadline to take place at the same time as those lodged before the deadline, <u>providing</u> there is sufficient time to make the appropriate arrangements. Otherwise, appeals lodged after the relevant deadline will be heard within **30 school days** of receipt of the appeal form

Lodging and appeal relating to an In-Year admission application decision

An appeal may be lodged within **30 school days** of the admission decision being issued. An appeal hearing will be scheduled to take place within **30 school days** of receipt of the appeal form
