The school's policy is to include all children on trips - no-one will be denied if they are not able to afford the trip cost. There will be a limited budget that can be used by parents whose children benefit from pupil premium funding (PPF). Last year the cost of trips was covered by contributions from parents, donations from the PTFA class fundraising, and an allocation from the school's pupil premium grant. The shortfall of £2500 was made up from the school's general income.
